Dear Mr. Cooper,

Thank you for your very kind letter reporting reception of our station on the morning of November 28, 1954. It was much appreciated. I am sorry that pressing duties have made it impossible for me to answer sooner.

I have checked our log for that date and can verify your report of reception of WMEN on the morning of November 28, 1954

At the latest census, Tallahassee had a population of 36,050. It came into being when Florida became one territory. There was a heated discussion at that time as to whether Jacksonville or Pensacola should be the capitol of Florida. The discussion was settled by having two widers start, one from Jacksonville and one from Pensacola, their meeting place to be the point of location for the new capitol. They met at a little indian village. The chief's name was "Tallahassee". Tallahassee is the Capitol of Florida and has two Universities.

Wmen signs on at 5:30 AM E.S.T. every morning and off at local sunset. Our frequency checks are made during our normal broadcast day, by Strain Engineering, Atlanta. I am very sorry but I have no coverage map that I could spare.

If you are ever in the vicinity of Tallahassee, stop in and see me.
