Good Morning Ernest

I usually don't answer these QSL reports since they are really of no use to the station. However when one is a persistent as you have been it seems wrong not to at least drop you a line and say hello.

Rick Seaby has moved to our station, WLAC, in Nashville Tn. and left me with what is one of the unique radio stations in the country. Our transmitter is located about 20 miles west of the city of Miami in the Everglades, a 75 mile wide river running from the center of the state south to the gulf of Mexico. The sight is totally under water with the towers and the transmitter building sitting on limestone fill and concrete pillars .

The weather here this year has been on the good side of fantastic. this morning it got down to about 62f for a low, the coldest it has been in over two months. The afternoons are usually in the low 80s.

Well I must get back to work, we are increasing our power from 5 Kw to 25Kw which means not only a new transmitter but new everything from the power transformers on the pole out front to the feedlines to the antennas. (We have five) There is much work to do and I must be about getting it done.
