Dear Mr. Cooper:

Thanks for the signal report from you area. The test went very well, and I received 4 phone calls during it as well as at least 2 dozen written reports in the mail. The farthest away was in California with 250 Watts. However your information is correct and your report of WOGO on January 24, 1972, on 1550 kHz, at 3:00 a.m. to 3:31 a.m. EST with 84 Watts until 3:30 and then 250 Watts is verified.

WOGO first went on the air in 1962 and our format is semi-rock music. We don't have an early morning frequency check. Our tower is a 151' quarter wave series fed non-directional radiator. We put out very well because were located on an island.

I have already informed the MRC of another test I will be conducting on February 28th from 2-4 a.m. EST. I hope this time there is enough time to let more DX'ers know.
