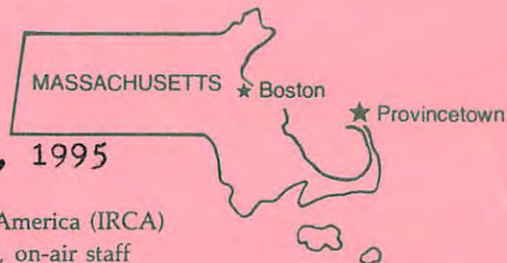

Your station has been making it in up here along about 5:10 p.m., sometimes with a solid signal, and other times very weak. I heard WOKV back in January and sent in a reception report then, with return postage, but I did not receive a reply. I am hoping for better luck this time, and I've changed the "Attention of" as you'll notice, as I have enclosed the carbon copy of that report from 1/31/95. But first, here's what I heard today on WOKV, and I hope it'll prove my reception.

Date: Thanksgiving Day 11/23/95 Frequency - 690 kHz.

- 5:12 p.m. (as WOKV first faded in) - Talk show on; caller from South Carolina. I heard mention of Gordon Liddy.
- 5:16:30 - Commercial for Christmas bargains - I couldn't catch the name of the sponsor, as your signal here was way under CBF, Montreal.
- 5:17 - Mention of "South Pacific" and the names of some of the songs. Said to call now to 641-1212.
- 5:18 - Commercial for Montgomery Ward. Doors open Friday at 6 a.m.!
- 5:19 - A few chimes heard.
- 5:19 - Commercial for Electronic Stock dealing, only \$19.95 per trade - call 1-800-STOCKS-3.
- 5:20 - Mentioned Jacksonville's new Talk station and added: You Talk; I listen. Then plugged the early morning 6-10 a.m. show.
- 5:20:30 - Back to the phones; talk about a rare book and communistic views.
- 5:24 - Female caller, talking about social behavior.

I lost WOKV after this - perhaps you went directional then? My receiver is an 18 tube 1963 Hammarlund HQ-180, with an indoor tuned ferrite loop. I've been a DX fan for som 63 years, and have 4,486 AM stations verified, many of which are no longer on the air. I have 218 from Florida, plus 48 FMs.

Please be so kind as to send me a brkef letter telling me my reception is correct, and if you could spare me one of your coverage maps, I'd be doubly pleased. Return envelope and postage are enclosed for your convenience in replying. I look forward to hearing from you, and I wish for you a very Blessed Christmas, and a successful new year of 1996, and - peace!
