I regret that your letter must have been lost in the mails, since we have no record of having received it. At any rate, we have checked the Station Schedule from our Log of February 1, 1947, and would like to verify your reception on that date as outlined by you from 6:00 a.m. to 6:10 a.m.

I regret local interference prohibits you from listening to WPDQ now that we have changed frequency from 1270 kc. to 600 kc. Since we will be on the air next Tuesday evening (election night) for some time beyond the usual sign-off, it may be that you are able to pick us up then.
