Dear Mr. Cooper,

This will verify your reception on 24 Feb 1975 of WRMF on 1060 kHz, from 154 to 2 am EDT. WRMF was operating with 10 KW, on a 2 tower (day) direction. Your report is the furthest from the North yet. Last report we recieved from up North, was an NRC er in Conn, last March at Sunset. We are AN 6 with SP MM. During the SP we do test. WRMF operates with 10 KW day/ directional and 4 KW Nite/directional ( 5 towers). WRMF simuls with WRMF FM ( STEREO 98.3 3 KW).

WRMF FM has the record for DX reports, with Texas and Duluth Minn, having heard the FM in Stereo within the past year. AM has been heard as far west as Ill, and also Mo.


We don't have a coverage map that would really be of any help, I'll search around and see what I can dig up, so you can get a look at the two patterns.

WRMF is a contemporary radio station. WRMF is the home of the Dolphins, Florida Gators, and Atlanta Braves. WRMF also from time to time airs local college and high school sports.

WRMF's transmitter/studio location is in Mims, Florida 10 miles north and slightly to the west of Titusville, on SR 46, about 4 miles West of 1-95. Transmitter/studio site has it's own orange grove.

DX in this state is unreal. Great if you like latins....Sunset stuff in the car is super, ie WFLI on days at top 1070 driving home from here on late afternoon. FPL ( the local buzz co) really makes summertime stuff a headache.
