This will verify your reception of Radio Station WSKP -
1450 on the dial - on November 4, 1957.

We operate 24 hours a day except that we are off the
air from 2:00 A.M. to 6 A.M. Monday mornings for
transmitter maintenance. Ours is a music station and
all talk is limited to 6 minutes per hour.

We operate on 250 watts, and have been in operation since
December 22, 1956. The former call letters were WWPB.
We are not affiliated with any other station. Sorry - we
have no coverage maps for distribution. Our call letters
WSKP make it convenient for us to ask our listeners to
"be an escapee with W S K P".

You did not hear an "interview on the subject of Atomic
Energy with a Navy Man" on this station, as all our music,
and commercials are taped, and we have no live broadcasts.
