
Dear Sir:

I have already sent out your verification of your DX report on WAAG, Herw in Adel, Ga. Sorry that no coverage map is available, however with the soil conductivity that prevails in this area, and the fact that non-directional antenna is used, good reception can usually be depended upon for a radius of about 60 miles in a circle.

Adel is a small town, just a wide place in the road so to speak, probably only about eight or nine thousand, however there are two other towns about the same size that are right close, so altogether we have a pretty good area to serve. I have no idea where Adel got its name unless it was somebody of that name that it was named for.
