Dear Sirs:

We appreciate your listening to our equipment test at 1206-0229 EST the morning of the 16th of August. We never thought we would get the response we did. The transmitter was being overhauled at that time and I have just finished working on all the final power circuits and transmission lines. Our Antenna is a series fed quarter wave single vertical. The Transmitter is an RCA STA-1B (1000 watts) located in College Park, Georgia operated remotely from our Studios near the Atlanta Air Terminal in Mapeville.

Corrected measurements for the morning of August 16:

Power, approximately 922 watts

Frequency, 1570.0045

Weather, Fair and Warm
