Dear Mr. Cooper,

This is to verify your report of reception of WLET on the morning of Jan. 5, 1953. Your report was absolutely correct.

We received quite a few reports from your section of the country, however most of our reports came from Penna. We also got some from Canada, the Midwest, Southwest and quite a few from the West Coast. Actually, thus far your report is the nearest one received.

WLET is the same station which you logged as WRMC a few years ago. The call letters were changed in 1948 when we added an FM transmitter. THE power of WLET-AM was changed two years ago from 250 watts fulltime to 1000 watts daytime only. The population of Toccoa is approx. 8,000 people and was named, as most small localities around here are, by the Cherokee Indian tribe. In their language Toccoa means "The Beautiful". Sure, glad to send you one of our regular coverage maps, it is enclosed. No, WLET is not directional. We have only one tower, which is 200' tall and series fed.
