
This is to verify your report of reception of Station WMJM. Thank you for your prompt answer to our request that all listners write us. We have had reports from all sections of the country.

Our equipment is RCA. Transmitter is a 250K crystal control with 2 810 tubes in the final stage. Our operating time is 6:45 till 10:00 P. M. We operate on 250 watts by day and 100 watts by night. We have a Hammarlund HQ120 receiver connected to the consolette. We are located in latitude 31o, 57' 45'' North and our longitude 83o, 47' 22'' West.

We are equipted to handle programs by electrical transcriptions, recordings, remotes, rebroadcasts and live talent within studios.
