Dear Mr. Cooper:

This letter is in effect, an answer to your "DX" report as referenced above. We are glad to verify your report as recorded and wish you continued success with your Georgia stations.

Just a little about our station: We are a 1,000 Watt-er (Daytime only) located on 1600 KCS. Our transmitter is a type BTA-IR by R.C.A. Our ground system, so far as I know, is just an ordinary 6" under type. (Not grounded in water, etc.) I do know however that some of our ground wires are broken or cut and perhaps we don't get out the way we should. Our frequency checks are supposed to be held on the third Monday of each month from 0045 until 01:15 or thereabouts. Oh yes, we are located just outside the city limits of Nashville, Georgia which is a small community of around 4700 persons. Nashville is located about 50-60 miles north of the Florida Line and is located on Highway 129.

I might mention that we received a "DX" report from another NRC member on the same date also, His name and address if you are interested is:
