For your information, WRCD began regular commercial broadcasting October 1, 1954, operating from 6:00 AM until local sunset, EST.


I didn't know there was another Honey around these parts. Will have to look Mr. R. L. Honey up, next time I'm around Sweetwater or Harriman, Tennessee.
