receiving our 1490 KC signal on December 16th.

I am happy to verify that you were receiving WSYL, in
Sylvania, as I have checked the program log for that date
and your report corresponds with the station log.

Our regular hours of broadcasting are from 6:00 A.M.
to 10:00 P.M. each day Monday through Saturday, and from
6:00 A.M. until 9:05 each Sunday. We schedule our frequency
checks on the first Sunday in each month.

I am not a Brooklynite, as I have lived most of my
life in the South. Sylvania has a population of approximately
four thousand and got it's name from the wooded area it
originally was.
