Dear Mr. Cooper;

Glad to get your latest letter.

It's my understanding that the prior ownership of WWGS & WCUP Radio did not often answer DX letters, which I do not understand, because he is a ham operator.

However, I have checked our files and found out that, YES, we did indeed run a frequency measurement at 3:49 a.m. E.S.T. on February 7, 1975.

You will not be able to find our frequency measurement tests anymore because we have contracted with a local company which can get our signal during the daytime hours. When we conducted the night time tests, we were being measured by a company in Birmingham, Alabama.

It is possible that you could receive our AM station at night, because our directional array blocks the south, and throws a strong lobe to the northeast.

I am returning the copies of your original correspondence that you sent me so that you will have them for your files.

Keep listening. I appreciate knowing where our signal is going.
