This is in answer to your letter of March 2, 1946, telling us of your reception of Radio Station KBUR on the morning of March 1, 1946.

This is to verify your reception of Radio Station KBUR on the morning of March 1, 1946 during our regular monthly frequency check with the commercial Radio Equipment Co., in Kansas City, Missouri. KBUR operates on a frequency of 1490 KC's and a power of 250 Watts. Regular monthly check always on the first Friday of each month, from 4:00 A. M. to 4:30 A. M., CST. Our station Log for that period tells us that KBUR was playing "The Washington Post" march, as you reported, at 4:25 AM.

WWSW and WJBK are chief complaints of all DX-ers reporting on reception of KBUR during our frequency checks or test broadcasts.

Hope this makes you very happy, being able to log a new station on 1490 this winter.
