This will verify your reception report of KGRN on October 9, 1957 at 1:18 a.m., Central Standard Time, broadcasting for equipment tests.


KGRN will go on the air on a regular basis on November first operating during daylight hours only. We plan a six a.m. sign-on time each day. Our regular frequency checks will be made the second Wednesday of each month from 5:30 to 5:45 a.m., Central Standard Time.

KGRN will be an independent operation with programming based on music and local news. We are affiliated with no other stations in ownership or programming.

I presume that the city of Grinnell, like Grinnell College which is located here, takes its name from a Mr. Grinnell; the one to whom Horace Greeley said "Go West, young man, go West". The current population is approximately 7800. The enclosed coverage map will give you some idea of our geographic location.
