Thanks very much for your letter stating that you heard the special DX program from KNWS.

Your report has been checked with the program log and found to be correct. This letter is VERIFICATION of your reception of KNWS on November 8, 1954 from 2:03 AM to 2:31 AM CST on their DX program.

KNWS uses a 205 foot tower and the transmitters, limiter and console are Raytheon. They operate from Sunrise to Sundown with a power of 1000 watts.

To date we have received 55 reports from 23 states. KNWS came into being in April 1953. Waterloo is located in North Eastern Iowa and has a population of 75,000 people. KNWS is a religious station owned by the Northwestern Schools of Minneapolis, Minn.

We surely enjoyed putting on this program for the National Radio Club and if your ever in the vicinity of Waterloo be sure and drop in at KNWS. Were hoping to meet you in person at the NRC convention this fall.
