Dear Mr. Cooper:

Many thanks for the report on our equipment test program of October 8th. That was our initial test, having just that evening hooked the antenna onto the transmitter.

We are using an RCA 250L transmitter, with a 330' Wincharger tower. Program, the time you picked us up, was originating from the transmitter control room.

As planned at the moment we have no further test programs scheduled, altho we expect to be on one more time after midnight before starting regular operations on Sunday, Oct 19th. At that time we will be on daytime only, from local sunup til sundown.

However, after the start of regular schedule we will probably be on around midnight each nite for about two weeks for frequency checks, pending delivery of our own freq measuring equipment.

Yes, in answer to your question about a special test program for dxers, I believe we could be very easily interested. We have given the matter a little thought - very little up to the moment, however, as other things have been of greater importance up to now.

We shall be very happy to hear from you at any time, either regarding future reception of our station - or in connection with the above special program.
