This letter is to verify your reception of WCTW on the morning of September 7, 1961..

Our station is not normally on at this hour of the day but on this particular day we were carrying a west coast baseball game with the Chicago White Sox. Our normal hours of broadcasting are from 5:55 A.M. to 10:15 P.M. but as you can see ball games carry us beyond this schedule. On Sundays our broadcast day is shorter with 7:50 A.M. to 6:15 p.m. the hours of operation for that day.

Enclosed you will find contour maps of our close in patterns for both daytime and nighttime operation. During daytime hours of operation we utilize two towers while at night we use four.

The contour maps are not accurate but just a rough pattern indication. During nighttime operation there are several minor lobes that are not indicated on the enclosed contour maps.

We thank you for the letter and wish you and the club the best of luck.
