This is to verify your report of March 24, 1968 indicating reception of our signal in your area from 1:57 am to 2:09.55 am E.S.T.

Our basic pattern is Northwest-Southwest with our major lobe in the Southeast direction. We do have to protect CBE, but also have to protect KXEL in Waterloo, Iowa. We accomplish our pattern with a 4 tower inline array.

Our regular hours are from 6:00 am until 10:15 pm Monday through Saturday, and from 7:30 am until 10:15 pm E.S.T. on Sunday. We do plan, however, to extend our hours shortly.

I can appreciate your special problem as images can be a real problem.

Could you please tell me what time CBE goes off the air?

In about 30 days we plan to go all night some night just to see what happens. For now, I can only say that it would probably be a Saturday night (Sunday morning). How much notice would you require to get this published?


