Dear Mr. Cooper:

I wish to acknowledge your letter reporting your reception of WGRY in Brooklyn, for our special DX Test Program conducted early Sunday morning, January 18th.

I want to apologize for the delay in verification of your report, but we received such an abundance of mail, it has been difficult in answering each and every one promptly. With a limited staff, it has taken us longer than anticipated, and I did want to answer each one personally.

I'm sorry you had to leave a party early in order to get home to hear WGRY.

Gary has a population of about 150,000 and WGRY covers more than 200,000 radio listeners in the Gary Retail trade area and serves over half a million people in the Calumet and adjacent region. Enclosed you will find a WGRY coverage map.

WGRY signs on at 6:00 a.m. Monday through Saturday, and at 7:15 a.m. (CST) on Sundays. Our 500 watts give complete coverage in ALL directions, and began broadcasting in the fall of 1950.

At present WGRY does not have a regular frequency check schedule in the early morning hours; however, if we should do so, we will let you know when it will occur.
