Dear Mr. Cooper:

The reception you heard as stated in your October 16, letter is herewith "VERIFIED" from our station log of October 15, 1950.

That was our first equipment check on the air but we have operated at intervals each night since except two with some daytime tests.

Our operation is a 500 watts AM on 1440 kilocycles daytime after we take the air on regular schedule that should be approximately November 12.

We have two 207' guyed Wincharger towers on a 301 degree angle, or a directional system with an irregular figure 8 pattern predominating in a southeast direction.


Two additional DX fans have reported very strong and clear reception from New York City that would appear our signal is predominant in that direction.

It is a pleasure hearing from you and we trust you are able to tune us in again during our further equipment tests that will run for about 10 more days and nights prior to our regular program schedule from there on.

If you ever get over in this part of the country by all means look us up as we have sufficient business sold for a good years operation and know we will be around that long.
