

This letter is to verify reception of WRSW, ~~WRSW-FM~~, by you  
on Sept. 29/52 at 2:25 a.m. C.S.T

WRSW operates on 1480 Kc. with an authorized radiated power of  
500 watts, using two 287' guyed towers and one 287' self support-  
ing tower in a three tower directional antenna array, and a  
Collins model 20V transmitter.

WRSW-FM operates on 103.7 Mc., with an effective radiated  
power of 34,000 watts, using an eight bay Collins antenna  
mounted along side the uppermost portion of a Truscon 287'  
self supporting tower. The transmitter is a Westinghouse  
type FM-3 running at 3,000 watts output.
