Remarks : Sorry that your report last year was not answered. However I was not the Chief Engineer here at that time so of course cannot offer an explanation for that. Hope this one will do the trick. We were using 500 watts power for our equipment tests and are happy that it gave such a good signal in Brooklyn. Our Frequency is checked with Commercial Radio Company of Kansas City and is done during our regular broadcast time. Kansas City is but about 25 miles from Leavenworth.
