Dear Mr. Cooper:

Thanks for your reception report of KGGF. Checking your list of selections verifies your having heard KGGF.

At the time you heard KGGF, we were testing the transmitter of our new 5/10 KW installation. The transmitter was roughly matched to one tower of our four tower array and was on 10 KW. When the installation is complete, we will be 10 KW day and 5 KW night with a different pattern day and night. Our null will be toward Montreal, Canada.

Coffeyville was named for Col. Coffey, one of the first settlers. The present population is about 18,000. Coffeyville is located in southeast Kansas, three miles north of the Kansas-Oklahoma state line, and is a center of farming, manufacturing and oil producing.
