Dear sir:

This verifies reception of radio station WCLU, 1320 kcs., 500 watts directional; on November 1, 1966; at 1:32:45 a.m. E.S.T.; during a proof of performance test.

The major lobes are towards Dayton, Ohio and Lexington, Kentucky. There are nulls at 73, 213, and 253 degrees from true North.

Please excuse the delay. Someone lost the original report and the response. I've not gotten veries from several foreign B. C. B. stations. I understand how you feel.

If you'd like some pirate veries, there are about ten different transmitters on 1610 kcs. in the area, varying in power from 6 to 500 watts. I can give you some of the addresses if you hear them. However, I haven't heard them on very much since I tracked them down with a d. f. They're pretty scared right now. I warned them, which is all that I could do.
