Thank you very much for your reception report and suggestions for our recent equipment check.

I am pleased to verify your reception of WKXO, 1500 kHz., 250 Watts, from 12:20 to 12:46 a.m. E.S.T. February 14, 1977. WKXO uses a 143 foot non-directional antenna and a Gates BC-250GY transmitter (arrived in Jan.)

So far, we've gotten reports from you in the east, Dr. Tom to the north (also someone in Marquette, Mich.), Skip Dabelstein in Kansas, and Gerry Thomas (IRCA) in Fla. Not bad, eh? The General Manager is very enthusiastic about the test and is interested in the N.R.C.

Your atlas is ok, but actually Berea is bounded by Big Hill on the east, Possum Kingdom on the west, Buggytown and Peggy's Flat on the north, and Scaffold Cane on the south. Still, hats off to a map that shows Clover Bottom, Paint Lick, Dreyfus, and Boone's Gap!

Daytime range is about 75 miles -- less to the south and east due to the abrupt rise in the Appalachians. We're on the last major ridge facing the Bluegrass, elev. 1,150'.

Again, many thanks for the report.
