Dear Mr. Cooper:

Received your DX report of Nov. 16th., and appreciate your interest in our station. This is to verify that report as correct and to give you a few highlights about KLOU.

We, as you surmised, have a two-element directional antenna with major lobes to the east, west, and south, and a minor lobe to the north. We use a composite transmitter and a Western Electric 25-B control console.

KLOU began operation last May 17th., with Mr. H. V. Anderson, of the radio engineering firm of Anderson & Merryman, as manager, and became an affiliate of the Columbia Broadcasting System on the first of this month.

To date, our most distant DX reports from in the states have come from Vermont and Washington state. We also have received five reports from New Zealand.

We accept reports on network programs if you give our exact station breaks, and have sent verifications on the same.

I hope this information and verification is sufficient for your files. And again let me thank you for your interest and report.
