Dear Mr. Cooper: -

I am sorry I overlooked your report of reception of our station KTDL, located here in Farmerville, La.:

I have examined your log of our broadcast (ME-ha) of June 10, 1964 and find it to be correct. and I am happy to verify it for you. KTDL is a "daytime" station, using a 1000 watt unit, turning a fall gate to a 2500 restricted series fed antenna.

We were on the air two years last Dec 7th. The tower has a pop. of approx 3000, a total parish pop. of 18000, with large towns up to 6500 pop (monroe, La) 20 air miles away.

I am the chief Eng. + v.c. pres. I teach electronics at the local vocational + tech school. They check come on, and we in each month operation is confirmed from Sun up to Sun down.

I come out here nearly every night + have things over-ha. I saw across your letter of Jan 19, 1965. I am on + out all day - while the station is on air. I am amateur W 5 MO - since 1930, operate 75 watts the time. His letter late those never. Regard
