Many thanks for your reception report on WATD-AM. It certainly was us you heard and we're glad to have the station back on the air at last.

I'm glad to hear you're working at WOMR. It's a nice station. I did the original FCC application for them some years ago and it's good to see them doing well.

By the way... have you ever considered moving WOMR up one Channel to 92.1 MHz. I understand that WUMB at U. Mass in Boston and WOMR frequently interfere with each other and that might solve the problem. When we originally designed WOMR it was set up so that the station could in the future move up one channel and operate either commercially or non-commercially depending on the needs and desires of the Board. Right now, WOMR is limited to strictly non-commercial operation. I think that U. Mass Boston is concerned enough about the interference that they might agree to underwrite the FCC paperwork costs to make the change. Please let me know if this idea interests anyone at WOMR.

It was nice to hear from you again. Good luck with the DXing. If you should get over to our neck of the woods, please stop by for a cup of coffee.
