
Dear Sir:

The management of W C O P appreciates the interest shown by you and other DX listeners throughout the country on the reception of our program on Sunday morning, September 22, 1935.

W C O P, Boston's newest radio station, was opened August 26, and has been on the air daily since that time. We operate on a day time schedule, signing off at sunset Boston time. Our transmitting facilities are located in Brighton, approximately 5 miles from the studios, which are in the Copley Plaza Hotel. We have radio R.C.A. equipment throughout and a self-supporting vertical radiator which is approximately 267 feet high.

Our coverage far exceeds the expectation of our engineering department and we sincerely hope that you will continue to listen on our frequency of 267.7 meters or 1120 kilocycles to what we now call Boston's newest radio station,
