
Thanks for your letter. It is nice to hear from radio listeners not only across the Atlantic, but from our own area as well.

I am pleased to inform you that your reception report on WMRE has been confirmed. You are one of the many in your area who has reported receiving our signal, so welcome to the WMRE Fan Club. We are always happy to hear from our broadcast DX friends.

WMRE-AM is owned by Mariner Communications and is licensed for 50 kilowatts around the clock. Our transmitter is a Harris MW-50B and is located in Waltham, Massachusetts, six miles west of our Boston studios and offices. We operate at an assigned frequency of 1510 kHz, with a two-tower directional pattern during the day, and a four-tower pattern at night. Because of the restrictions on where our signal may travel, WMRE is aimed primarily east during our night time hours, This is why we are frequently heard in Europe.

Thanks for your letter, and don't hesitate to write to us again.
