Thank you very much for your report of our / <sup>regular</sup> broadcast on Jan. 15, 1956. According to our records, we can verify your report of reception on the date and time indicated.

W P L M is a daytime Station, with sign on Monday through Saturday, at 6:00 A.M., and sign off at local sunset. Sundays we sign on at 8:00 A.M. W P L M operates with a power of 500 watts, through a Gates RC-500 GY Transmitter. In fact, W P L M is equipped with Gates equipment through out. Our Tower is approximately 300 ft. above sea level, and is located North Lat. 41° 56' 37" and West Lat. 70° 42' 06". W P L M has frequency checks taken once a month, usually the second day, during regular program hours. Equipment checks always occur at midnight on the night of the test. Otherwise, there is no set schedule.

W P L M is located in one of America's outstanding tourist spots. Plymouth was the home of the early settlers and the point at which the Mayflower finished its' long journey from England to the New World. The world famous "Plymouth Rock" is located in Plymouth at the point of the landing of the Pilgrims, and only a few blocks from the W P L M Studios. Many of the original buildings of the Pilgrims have been preserved, and are open to tourists in the summer months. There are also numerous monuments all over the Plymouth area, dedicated to the early settlers and the most outstanding is the Monument of the Forefathers, the largest all granite statue in the world.

Plymouth is also the gateway to the vacation wonderland of Cape Cod. The summer months find thousands of people from all over the United States coming to the Cape Cod area for fun and recreation in the warm sun and the fresh ocean breezes.

It is a pleasure to add your name to our list of W P L M listeners, no matter how far you are from Plymouth. You have heard the voice of America's Home Town, Plymouth, Massachusetts. Thank you for your time and trouble in reporting once again.
