As always it is a pleasure to confirm your report of reception of WSNY Boston. I say always as I am sure I have verified others for you from Boston and also Florida.

Thought you might get a kick out of a copy of some maps I had, as you can see, CHSJ's 0.5 MV/M contour is not far off the top of Cape Cod.

WSNY operates with 5,000 watts with separate patterns for day and night. The antenna system consists of 3 270' self-supporting Blaw-Knox towers on a northwest by southeast line located in Lexington.

Our transmitters are RCA BTA-5L2 and BTA-5T1.

In answer to your questions, WSNY is on 24 hours a day, 7 days a week except for an unusual circumstance such as antenna system work, etc.

WSNY is the sister station of WHUE, both are owned by General Cinema Communications of Boston.
