Dear Ernest:

Thanks for your report on the reception of WUOK on February 8th. This will verify that your log of our operations that night is accurate. WUOK was testing a new automatic change-over system for the transmitters.

You might be interested to know that WUOK is the former WOCB. The main transmitter is a 1KW, solid state Harris, and the auxiliary is a 1KW tube type Gates, using a pair of 833-A's in the PA. The new system is designed to change transmitters automatically should the main fail.

WUOK (AM) and WXTK (FM) are on the air twenty four hours a day, and maintenance is accomplished by changing to the auxiliary transmitters.

Thanks, again, for your interest; we always welcome DX reports.
