Dear Sir,

The program you had listed in your reception report of WBOC on the morning of November 8th was correct.

No doubt you did have difficulty hearing WBOC. The power output of our transmitter is 1 kw. We do have a directional array at night which protects WELI and also WDBJ in Roanoke, Va. One lobe radiates northwestwards and one radiates in a southeasterly direction. That would put you practically in a null. Our coverage at night does not give very satisfactory listening beyond 50 miles or so. We radiate in all directions during daylight hours and cover practically all of the Delmarva peninsula. This is quite an increase over the coverage which 250 watts on the 1230 k/cs frequency gave WBOC. We are on the air from 6 AM until 1 35 AM. WBOC-FM is on a frequency of 97.5 m/cs with an effective radiated power of 12 kw.

Accept our invitation to visit with us if you have the opportunity. We wish you success in your club work and theatre work and also wish you many happy DX hours.
