Dear Mr. Cooper:

Thank you for your DX letter of October 24, 1948. We are sorry to have been delayed in verifying your letter. We are happy to say that your reception of our Station was entirely correct.

In answer to your inquiry as to whether or not we will be on the air every Sunday morning, as we were on the particular date you listened, yes we are on every Sunday morning from 1:05 AM to 3:00 AM. We will have the same type program, with the exception that requests will be filled by mail instead of by telephone.

Our maintenance watch by our engineer department is indefinite, at the present time, but usually is done between 3:00 AM and sign on Sunday morning and on Thursday from 1:05 AM to 3:00 AM, when maintenance is necessary. As to when the new Cumberland station on 1240 KC/s. will be ready is in a waiting period and has not officially been granted a CP (construction permit).
