This letter serves to confirm reception of our stations on March 11 and 12, 1994, and on May 5 and 7, 1994. **RADIO ZONE - THE KIDS' STATIONS** began broadcasting on WKDL 1050 AM on February 25, 1993, and in Manassas, Virginia, on WKDV 1460 AM in May of 1993. Our Towson station, WKDB 1570 AM, began broadcasting in the Baltimore area in November of 1993.

RADIO ZONE broadcasts its own morning show weekdays from 6:00 to 11:00 AM. The remainder of our programming is provided by Radio AAHS via satellite. Originating in Minneapolis, Minnesota, Radio Aahs has been on the air for almost five years. In 1993, they began their satellite network. There are now affiliates in sixteen cities across the country, and several more affiliates are expected to join the network in the near future.

Why does Radio Aahs provide programming for children at 1 or 2 in the morning? Kids are kids twenty-four hours a day. Music and stories appropriate for children can be very comforting to a child who is up late at night because of nightmares or illness.
