Mr. Dan O'Neil forwarded your letter to me for reference.


I am glad to confirm your reception of WYST-AM on November 6, 1989. Considering the power of WINS, 50,000 watts directionally pointed East, I am pleased that even this minimal reception was possible. We broadcast at 1010 AM with 1,000 watts, non-directional between sunrise and sunset, and night power at 27 watts. During the test we were broadcasting with 1,000 watts.

Our studios are located at 1111 Park Avenue in Baltimore, and our transmitter is at 1315 Hamburg Street also in Baltimore.

Our parent company, United Broadcasting Company, in addition to owning WYST AM (1010) and 92 STAR, FM, in Baltimore, also owns radio stations in New York City, Rockville, Md., Washington, DC, Los Angeles and San Francisco, in California and Cleveland, Ohio. We also own cable companies in New Hampshire and Vermont.
