
This will confirm your reception of W F S T from 12:01 to 12:25 a.m. (est) on December 12, 1960.

We do not operate for the benefit of DX-listeners; however, we are pleased to acknowledge reception of our station during our routine frequency measurements from 12:00 to 12:30 a.m. (est) on the second Saturday of each month.

Our sign-on time is at 6:00 a.m. daily, and 8:00 a.m. on Sundays. We operate with 5000 watts, non-directional, daytime only. Our FM station (W F S T - FM) operates until 11:05 p.m. each day on 97.7 mc/s.

The "F S T" in our call stands for Forrest S. Tibbetts owner of the station.

W F S T has been in operation for nearly five years and has been promoted as Maine's Most Powerful Independent Radio Station. We serve the listeners throughout Aroostook County, Maine and neighboring New Brunswick and Quebec, Canada with the best in music and news coverage. Our FM is very popular and a weekly AM-FM live and recorded stereophonic program is well received-- on W F S T, "Where Fidelity Sounds Terrific".
