Dear Mr. Cooper;

Thank you for noting the call letter change of WYNZ-AM (I still call it WCSH...HA!) to 970kHz, WZAN.

There have been absolutely no changes to speak of in the 970 transmitting plant since 1983. We're using a Continental Model 315R "Power Rock" 5kW Pulse-Width Modulated transmitter and a 2 tower array for night time operation. The main lobe of the pattern indeed covers your QTH (a little CW lingo there Rush fans!) quite well.

Unfortunately, no coverage maps are currently available (I'm having new ones done up later this month). I have, however, included at WZAN program schedule, and anything else I could steal for you.

If you ever visit Maine, please feel free to stop by our studios conveniently located near the Maine Mall and the Portland International Jetport in So. Portland, Maine.

We have four stations under one roof here, and being the ONLY staff engineer, it at time takes me a while to catch-up on the mail. My apologies.

I've been the Chief Engineer for 560kHz WGAN for almost four years now, and most recently WZAN, which we recently purchased.
