Dear Mr. Cooper,

Thank you for your letter and log of our DX pgm.
November 23. I am pleased to send you this
VARIFICATION of your reception of our station.

Your report was one of the few we received telling
of little difficulty with WEDC. Your log was
very accurate. During the program we mentioned
that this program was the first DX broadcast for
WATT, but later we found that during tests in 1947
DX requests were made. Many N.R.C. members wrote
to say that they had logged WATT at that time.

Station WATT began operation in September 1945, and
at that time was the second station of the Paul
Bunyan Network. We now have five AM stations and
a C.P. for Ch. 7 for a TV station at WTCM.

The City of Cadillac has about 11,000 population
with a number of small surrounding communities.
It was named after the discoverer of Detroit.
Cadillac cars are NOT made here but other well
known products are....Ehris-Craft boats and B. F.
Goodrich rubber products. Cadillac is also the
home of Caberfae, winter sports capital of the
Mid-West.
