Dear Mr. Cooper:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of November 15th, and confirm your report of reception of WGFG on 1360 kcs, 5:44 am to 5:56 am est, on November 14, 1947.

You may be interested in knowing that WGFG began its first full day of broadcasting on August 8th, 1947. It is a 1,000 watt ABC affiliate. At the studios we use RCA turntables, pickups and speech equipment. The transmitter is a Raytheon RA-1000 located $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles northeast of Kalamazoo, and the antenna phasing equipment is Johnson. We use a directional antenna consisting of four 300-foot Blaw-Knox towers. Our directional pattern is such as to protect Green Bay, Wisconsin, Hartford, Connecticut, and Cincinnati, Ohio.

We appreciate your report and thank you for your interest in our signal.
