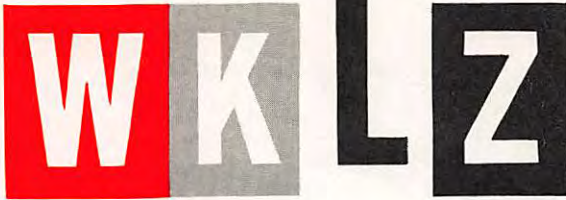



It's always interesting to read the DX report or two that come in after a night's transmitter test. This is the first time we have received one as far east as Brooklyn, probably due to WSAN's all-night clambake.

The transmission you logged was our regular monthly broadcast for frequency check, made by a lab in Detroit..it's the second Wednesday morning each month from 1 - 1:15 AM. Usually, my assistant, Jim Kirklin does it and he usually operates before and after this period for awhile, as well.

Our sign-on is 5:30 Weekdays and 7 Sundays, EST. WKLZ is 3½ years old and is affiliated with the Mutual network, operating 'til local sunset. The call letters are intended to tie us to the name of the city, W-KaLamaZoo. Also, it is interesting to note you're having logged the other Kalamazoo stations, as well. There is one left, but that's FM, the 36 KW station operated by WMCR, Western Michigan University.

Attached is a copy of our ground-wave coverage, estimated to the 0.1 MV/M contour. Many thanks for your interest.
