HOWEVER WE HAVE BEEN GRANTED A FULLTIME LICENCE BY THE FCC AND ARE WAITING NOW FOR THE FINAL OK TO GO AHEAD. WHEN THE FINAL OK COMES WE WILL CHANGE FROM 1540KC TO 1340 KC AND PROBABLY STAY ON TILL 11:00P.M.

WE HAVE BEEN ON THE AIR FIVE YEARS NOW AND OUR SERVICE AREA COVERS ALL OF THE UPPER THUMB. IN CASE YOUR INTERESTED WE PLAN TO RUN A PROOF OF PERFORMANCE TEST NEXT WEEK, POSSIBLY TUES. OR WED. MORNING. HOPONG TO HEAR FROM YOU AGAIN REAL SOON.
