Your reception of WSGW of June 16/17, 1951 is hereby VERIFIED.

Actually WSGW does not push too much signal in your direction as the lobes are beamed NNW and WSW to cover Saginaw and Bay City.

The array here is 6 towers and they are staggered in two sets of 3. Needless to say we put a good 25 millivolts into both Saginaw and Bay City. Approximately 21 surrounding counties are included in the secondary coverage area.

It is very probable that you did hear a ballgame being aired earlier in the evening because we carry the Saginaw Jackrabbits games (Central League) These games are mostly night games starting about 8:00 PM EST. We also carry Detroit Tiger night games.

The only information I have at present about the city name is that it came from an indian chief in this area.

Dont do too much DXing myself but once in a while the ole SX25 picks up wqxr for some good music.
