
Dear Mr Cooper,

Thanks so much for your report of reception on the morning of November 29. It is very gratifying to know our signal is so good.

WAVN changed call letters about $1\frac{1}{2}$ or 2 years ago at about the same time power was increased to 1,000 watts. I'm not sure of the reason, as I was not employed here at the time, but I believe it had something to do with the increased coverage with more power.

As to frequency checks...we don't have a schedule for that in early morning hours, primarily because our frequency is checked by a lab in the Minneapolis area, and we are close enough to them to have this done during regular hours. We operate on a local sunrise-sunset schedule...during December this is 7:45AM - 4:30PM CST. Hardly enough time to get the rig warmed up.

Thanks again for your report, and from all of us here, a very Merry Christmas and a good year to come.
