Dear Mr. Cooper:

Please excuse the delay in answering your request for verification of the reception of WCOV which you asked for in your letter of August 21. Your apologies for not requesting this until this late date are naturally accepted because of your leaving on your vacation and I wish to add that quite a number of other DX fans have been late with their request, but not more so than we have been in our replies of verification as you know getting a new station on the air is quite a project.

Your data as of our reception of WCOV on 1590 Kilocycles, August 2, 1951, 2:30 to 2:38 CST and logged to 2:59/30 seconds CST is entirely correct.

WCOV operates on 5,000 Watts power as a daytime station. Our sign-on is at 5:00 A.M. continuous for the year. However, sign-off is local sunset. WCOV is non-directional and at the present time I am unable to give you any definite dates of regular equipment tests.

Thank you for your interest in WCOV and we appreciate your adding this verification to your long list of verifications of radio stations operating on the standard broadcast band.
