Dear Mr. Cooper:

We wish to thank you for your report of reception of station WELY 3:30 thru 3:42 AM C.S.T. on the morning of December 27th, 1954. Check of your report with our log confirms your report and you can consider this letter as verification of your reception of WELY.

WELY went on the air October 2, 1954, and the station uses the same transmitter and antenna formerly used by WXLN which ceased operation in June 1950. I do not know how Ely got its name but the population is a little over 6,000 and growing. Ely is in northern Minnesota, about 85 miles northeast of Duluth, Minnesota. We are 20 miles from the Canadian border. WELY does not have any early morning frequency check period at the present. Normal operating hours are 6 AM to 10 PM C.S.T. WELY can be heard over an area with radius of 75 miles and reception in that area is constantly reported.
